Appointment of Directors

1. Approach to Appointing Directors

The information herein outlines Mitsubishi Corporation's approach to appointing its Directors.

Each appointment is discussed separately by the Governance, Nomination and Compensation Committee, whose members consist mainly of Independent Directors and Independent Audit & Supervisory Board Members ^{*}. The final decisions are made by Mitsubishi Corporation's Board of Directors.

Mitsubishi Corporation's Directors are experienced and knowledgeable specialists who are appointed from both within and outside the company. Their combined expertise is needed to ensure that the company's decision making and management oversight are appropriate for a *sogo shosha* involved in diverse businesses and industries.

In addition to the Chairman of the Board and the President & CEO, Mitsubishi Corporation's In-house Directors are elected from Executive Officers responsible for companywide management, Corporate Staff operations, and other areas. Outside Directors are elected from highly experienced corporate managers. They possess specialized expertise and objectivity on global developments and socioeconomic trends.
